## BYOD Student Agreement

Students must read and sign the BYOD Student agreement in the company of their parent/carer. Both student and parent must sign the agreement, and then return it to the Office at Warilla High School

- ▽ Use the DEC's Wi-Fi network for learning.
- ▽ Use my device during school activities following the direction of my teacher.
- ▽ Use my own portal/internet log in details and never share them with other students.
- ▽ Stay safe by not giving my personal information to strangers.
- ▽ Not hack or bypass any hardware and software security which has been implemented by the DEC or Warilla High School.
- ▽ Not use my own device to knowingly search for, link to, access or send any item that is offensive, pornographic, threatening, abusive, defamatory or bullying.
- ▽ Report any inappropriate behaviour or inappropriate material to my teacher.
- ▽ Understand that my activity on the internet is recorded and that these records may be used in investigations, court proceedings or for other legal reasons.
- ▽ Acknowledge that Warilla High School cannot be held responsible for any damage to or theft of my device.
- ▽ Read and understand the limitations of the manufacturer's warranty on my device, both in durability and coverage.
- ▽ Read and comply with the BYOD Student Responsibilities document.
- ▽ Read the BYOD Device Requirements and ensure my device meets the minimum specifications.

## Warilla High School BYOD Student Responsibilities

Operating system and anti-virus	Students must ensure they have a legal and licensed version of a supported operating system and software. If applicable, students' devices must be equipped with anti-virus software.
NSW DEC Wi-Fi network connection only	Student devices are only permitted to connect to the Department of Education's Wi-Fi network while at school. There is no cost for this service.
Battery life and charging	Students must ensure that they bring their device to school fully charged. No charging equipment will be supplied by the school.
Theft and damage	Students are responsible for securing and protecting their devices at school. Any loss or damage to a device is not the responsibility of the school or the DEC.
Confiscation	Students' devices may be confiscated if the school has reasonable grounds to suspect that a device contains data which breaches the BYOD student agreement.
Maintenance and support	Students are solely responsible for the maintenance and upkeep of their devices.
Ergonomics	Students should ensure that they are comfortable using their devices during the school day, particularly in relation to screen size, sturdy keyboard etc.
Data back-up	Students are responsible for backing up their own data and should ensure that this is done regularly.
Insurance/warranty	Students and parents/carers are responsible for arranging their own insurance and should be aware of the warranty conditions for their device.
